Unstacking Certain Tariffs

EFFECTIVE DATE: May 16

- Products subject to Auto/Auto Parts 232 will not be subject to MX IEEPA, CA IEEPA, Aluminum/Steel 232
- Products subject to MX IEEPA or CA IEEPA will not be subject to Aluminum/Steel 232
- Products subject to Aluminum 232 will continue to be subject to Steel 232 and vice versa
- Exclusions apply
